Aspects	Comments
Communication and Rapport: <i>This includes:</i> <i>introduction to the patient, allowing the patient to speak freely, active listening skills,</i> <i>Use of open and closed ended questions,</i> <i>recognition of verbal and non-verbal cues, exploring patient concerns, use of language appropriately,</i> <i>exploring appropriate psychosocial aspects.</i>	
History Taking: <i>This includes:</i> <i>Ability to take a focused and relevant history,</i> <i>eliciting of relevant positive and negative information, logical approach and progression,</i> <i>addresses patients concerns, checks patient understanding.</i>	
Problem definition: <i>This includes:</i> <i>Ability to identify the relevant problems and patient concerns, to define and prioritise the physical, psychological and social issues.</i>	
Management Plan: <i>This includes:</i> <i>Prioritising the problems elicited, developing a management plan, defining appropriate investigations, arrangements for follow-up,</i> <i>strategies for safety netting, use of appropriate resources, discussing and negotiating the plan with the patient, exploring patient issues</i>
